- Tambourine:** Starts with a rest, then plays a melodic line marked *pp* and *ff*.
- Snare drum:** Starts with a rest, then plays a melodic line marked *pp* and *ff*.
- Bass drum:** Starts with a rest, then plays a melodic line marked *pp* and *ff*.

**Other Instruments:**

- Harp:** Starts with a rest, then plays a melodic line marked *pp* and *ff*.
- Violin I:** Starts with a rest, then plays a melodic line marked *pp* and *ff*.
- Violin II:** Starts with a rest, then plays a melodic line marked *pp* and *ff*.
